Instructions for Registering on MyLearningPlan

- Go to [www.berksiu.org](http://www.berksiu.org)
- Click on the "Quick Links" drop down box toward the top of the main page.
- Choose "MyLearningPlan" from the list.
- Select Step 1: "Click here to view course catalog".
- Events are in order by dates. Scroll down to "date of event" or enter the title in the "Search Term" box.
- Then click "View Now".
- Choose "title of event" session by clicking on the course title for course description and enrollment information.
- Select "Click to Enroll" and choose the link that applies to you. Example, "I'm a new user".
- Enter your information as instructed.
